BOARD ROOM BRIEFING The Lorain County Board of DD convened at 6:30 p.m. on February 25, 2019:

Superintendent Fisher reviewed provisions of Ohio Revised Code 2111.52 related to Guardianship Services Boards; further discussion is expected about exploration of this arrangement in Lorain County. The Board resolved unanimously to recommend to the Lorain County Commissioners for approval a negotiated agreement with the Ohio Association of Public School Employees; the agreement pertains to the period July 01, 2019 – June 30, 2022. The Board approved an Action Plan for Educational Services and the Meister Rd. Home, and Agency calendars for 2019/2020. The Board unanimously approved revisions to the Murray Ridge School Wellness Policy, as well as policies on (Intermittent Employee) Compensation, and Reimbursement of Work-Related Expenses. Dr. Fisher updated the Board on highlights of the proposed state biennial budget, including provisions related to Direct Support Professional wages, the reimbursement rate for Non-Medical Transportation, the provider suspension process, and county board of DD cash forecasts. Superintendent Fisher and the Board established topics for the Board's 2019 continuing education credits; topics will include the New MUI/UI Rule and Responsibilities of Board Members as Mandated Reporters, Proposed Changes to Non-Medical Transportation, and the Status of Vocational Habilitation.
