BOARD ROOM BRIEFING The Lorain County Board of DD convened at 6:30 p.m. on May 24, 2021:

Superintendent Fisher reported that there were no recommended changes to the proposed 2020 Strategic Plan Progress Report as a result of the public forum on this topic held on May 17, 2021; the Board approved the 2020 Strategic Plan Progress Report, as presented. Dr. Fisher provided an update on the Murray Ridge Adult Services transition, currently underway. Some of the 197 people who were notified that they will not be able to receive Adult Day Support or Vocational Habilitation from Murray Ridge Adult Services after a date, yet to be announced, in 2021, have secured alternative providers. Dr. Fisher announced that a number of providers have expressed interest in providing Adult Day Support and/or Vocational Habilitation in sections of the building that houses the Murray Ridge Elyria Opportunity and Vocational Center (EOVC), and interested individuals have been invited to a 'virtual/remote venue' to hear from these providers; some recommended terms of the lease(s) to be offered to one or more of the interested providers were approved. (Murray Ridge Adult Services will continue to operate in the sections of EOVC that are not leased.) Dr Fisher announced that transportation to all community-based group employment sites would resume on June 14, 2021. The Board passed a motion to resume bus transportation to the OVCs effective July 19, 2021, to individuals otherwise eligible to receive in-person services in these settings; the busing will not be available to those that were notified that they will not be able to receive Adult Day Support or Vocational Habilitation from Murray Ridge Services after a date (yet to be announced) in 2021. The five-year financial forecast of the agency and related considerations were reviewed. Dr. Fisher reported on the 'Royal Banquet' that was held for the Murray Ridge School Class of 2021, and announced that the keynote speaker at the Transition Ceremony (held June 02, 2021) would be Elyria Mayor Frank Whitfield.
