This June, Murray Ridge Center (MRC) sent 48 athletes to the 2015 Special Olympics Ohio State Summer Games.

The Murray Ridge athletes competed in a variety of sporting events, including bocce, volleyball, tennis, track, and soccer.

training and competition program for children and adults with developmental disabilities.

The Games, which were held June 26-28 at The Ohio State University in Columbus, featured more than 2,600 competitors in eleven sports, and included movies and recreational clinics. Athletes and chaperones were housed in the Ohio State University dormitories and were provided six meals through the University's Student Union Services.

The weekend was kicked off with opening ceremonies on Friday evening, June 26, at Jesse Owens Track and Field Stadium. The symbolic lighting of the Olympic Flame of Hope officially opened the Games, and was followed by a dance and fair provided by hundreds of volunteers.

Murray Ridge proudly supports the Special Olympics throughout the year. Additional volunteers are needed to continue to strengthen the MRC Program, and it is hoped that in 2016 the Murray Ridge Center Special Olympics Program will be better than ever!

BOARD ROOM BRIEFING

The Lorain County Board of DD convened at 12:30 p.m. on June 26, 2015:

The second quarter Exceptional Service Award will be presented at the August Board Meeting. The Board unanimously established the dollar amount that the Family Support Parent Committee is authorized to approve in the third quarter of 2015. A policy revision to *Management/Confidential: Bonus Time and Sick Leave Conversion Option* was unanimously approved. Superintendent Amber Fisher spoke on the Agency's recent Accreditation review. Superintendent Fisher also provided updates on the State of Ohio Biennium budget and the "Conflict-Free Case Management issue." The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has advised the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities that, until 2024, Medicaid waiver funding will not be withdrawn for adult services provided to individuals who are already, or are currently scheduled to participate, in county board-operated adult services programs. Additional information on this topic will be provided, as it becomes available. In other business, it was reported that the Murray Ridge Support Group (MRSG) will not meet again until September 8th, and September 18th will be the date of the next dance. There will be no Board meeting in July.
