#### BOARD ROOM BRIEFING The Lorain County Board of DD convened at 6:30 p.m. on February 27, 2017:

Superintendent Fisher provided a recap of 2016 expenditures, and a year-to year comparison of budgeted and actual expenditures in key categories. The Board approved an allocation for the Family Support Parent Committee to authorize families to use in the second quarter of 2017. Board member training requirements for 2017 were presented; the possibility of including a Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) webinar on the Future of Adult Day Services as a required training component was discussed. Annual benchmarks addressing provider recruitment and direct service to Medicaid waiver recipients were considered; submission by each county board to DODD of annual benchmarks relevant to these topics is a requirement of the Free Choice of Provider Rule (OAC 5123:2-9-11).
