# Murray Ridge Surpasses Goal for 50 Acts of Giving Back Initiative

Murray Ridge Center has exceeded its goal of Fifty Acts of Giving Back in 2017!

On January 1, 2017, Murray Ridge Center kicked off its "**Fifty Acts of Giving Back**" project, a 50-year anniversary initiative whereby, in 2017, members of the Murray Ridge family will 'give back' through (at least) fifty acts of helping to meet needs in Lorain County.


This initiative was designed as a 'thank you' to the community that has generously supported the Agency in providing lifelong services for thousands of Lorain County residents with developmental disabilities.

## As of May 2, 102 Murray Ridge Adult Program participants have completed 61 acts through volunteer work!

This number far exceeds our initial 50 Acts goal, but we have no plans of stopping there. Our Murray Ridge program participants, including adults at our Opportunity/Vocational Centers and students from Murray Ridge School, will continue to provide these volunteer acts throughout 2017, and into the future.

The Lorain County Board of DD convened at 6:30 p.m. on April 24, 2017:

Director of Business Greg Westgate reviewed with the Board on the tax budget, and it was unanimously approved. The 2017-2018 Agency calendars were discussed and approved. The Board approved updates to the policy on *Early Intervention*. The Board also unanimously approved an increase in wages for Murray Ridge School Summer Camp employees; the summer camp will be three weeks long in 2017, and will need to be limited to forty campers. The Board welcomed new Director of Human Resources Faira Corbett.
